Lenten Rules for Fasting & Abstinence

In the United States, the Fridays of Lent are days of abstinence. Ash Wednesday and **Good Friday** are days of **fast** and **abstinence**. The law of fast obliges all those from 18-59 to refrain from eating meals and to limit their eating to one full meal and two lighter meals for the day. The law of abstinence obliges those 14 years of age and older not to eat meat.

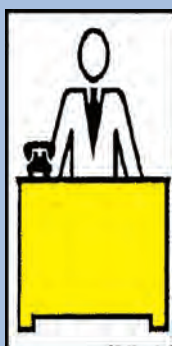
