People have asked why Father does not bring enough consecrated hosts to the communion line?

Liturgical guidelines of the Church direct the priest to distribute hosts consecrated at the Mass in which the people attend. Therefore, we distribute the hosts consecrated at Mass before we distribute the hosts reserved in the Ciborium. When we run out of hosts consecrated at Mass (because we can only estimate how many people will be receiving Communion), Father Hourican or Deacon Scott returns to the altar to distribute the hosts we kept in reserve.

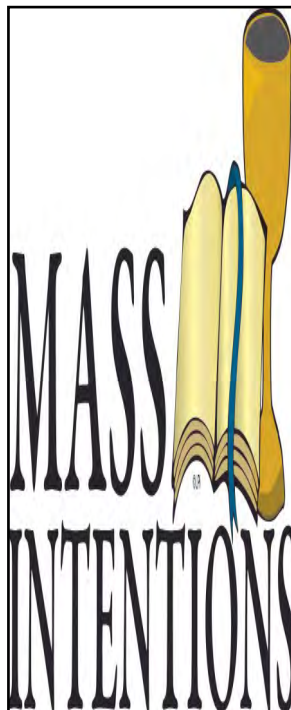

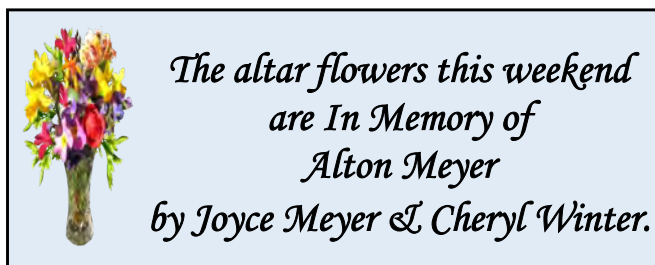

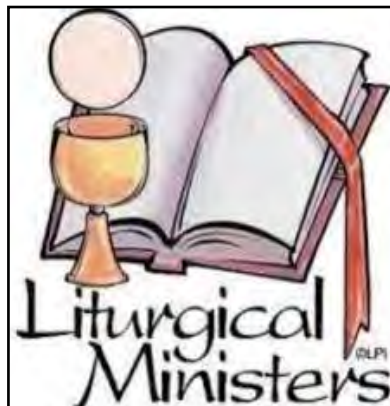
